EXTERNAL HOME STUDY Is required for components and encompasses anatomy & physiology, principles of massage, revision, study for class quizzes/assessments, workbooks, treatment plans, to have knowledge of computer software such as MS Word or similar. It would also be of advantage (but not essential) to have internet access for researching information. It is preferable that all workbooks are typed/saved and/or copied prior to submission.

WHAT TO BRING TO CLASS Massage table (if you have one), 3 towels, 1 sheet, 1 pillow, massage balm (provided at 1st class), antibacterial soap, disinfectant wipes, writing equipment and water proof band-aids. HLT42015 CERTIFICATE IV IN MASSAGE THERAPY

HLT42015 Certificate IV in Massage Therapy will be your introduction to the world of massage and your first step towards achieving professional massage recognition. You will learn the base requirements involved with massage as a therapy. You will gain understanding of Anatomy and Physiology ie. studies of the muscular and skeletal systems of the body. You will learn to associate and appreciate the body's biomechanical actions as a system, often closely related to muscular dysfunction and pain. You will also learn and develop hands on massage skills.

During your classes you will be guided through the process of perfecting a variety of effective massage techniques. Students work together in pairs and you are sure to enjoy and benefit from receiving regular massages.

After you have successfully completed the HLT42015 Certificate IV in Massage Therapy you may choose to join a professional association. You will also be able to apply for affordable professional indemnity insurance and gain professional

HLT52015 DIPLOMA OF REMEDIAL MASSAGE



HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial Massage is a more advanced course preparing practitioners to treat clients using massage. You will be introduced to the base requirements of massage therapy leading into a variety of individual modules which will provide flexibility and skill in the treatment of your clients. Diploma students will also master postural and orthopaedic assessments, preparing them to create suitable treatment plans for their clients and work remedially. At this level graduates may develop skills that may significantly change a client's physical structure assisting with recovery or pain management.

After you have successfully completed the HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial Massage you may choose to join a professional association. You will also be able to apply for professional indemnity insurance and gain professional support.

It should be noted that health fund eligibility requires amongst other criteria, a HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial Massage qualification.

REMEDIAL MASSAGE MODULE

Will provide you with the skills necessary to work remedially. After developing your foundation massage techniques you will be ready to learn more about the art of massage treatment. You will learn how to correctly assess the body's muscular structure and the appropriate massage techniques to assist/relieve discomfort. You will learn how to assess/treat/rehabilitate or assist a range of musculo-skeletal conditions.

LYMPHATIC MASSAGE MODULE

The lymphatic system is the major drainage system of the body. It plays a key role in the defence & surveillance of the body, it functions in immune response, assisting in the maintenance of fluid balance by draining fluid from the tissues, and then returning vital substances back to the blood stream. You will learn skills to assist this vital system. You will gain knowledge of the functions of the Lymphatic System and conditions effected by poor Lymphatic performance and contraindications to treatment and how to refer on when required.

MYOFASCIAL RELEASE THERAPY 1 MODULE

Will introduce you to a fascinating system of working with the framework of the body which is held together by fascia. You will be aware that fascial tissue surrounds/fuses with every structure of the body, enveloping muscles, organs and nerves. You will gain an understanding of how fascia can inhibit muscular function even after you have applied your massage skills to an area. This interesting module will provide you with treatment options.

TRIGGER POINT THERAPY MODULE

Designed for you to enhance/refine your palpation skills. Learn to locate/treat trigger points in the skeletal muscles and in the muscle's fascia. Trigger Point can be easily incorporated into your treatment programs, especially your neck, shoulder and lower back routines. Trigger points are located through palpation (by touch). Understand predictable pain patterns of active trigger points and the role of latent trigger points in muscle dysfunction as well as detect the perpetuating factors which activate trigger points.

SPORTS MASSAGE MODULE

Enhance your understanding of injuries and their treatment through this module. Learn effective pre- and post-event massage techniques to enhance speed, endurance and prevention of injury. Master maintenance and conditioning massage to use between sports events to assist bring about full recovery. Develop skills to assess and recognise signs and symptoms of common sporting injuries and develop effective treatment options.

PREGNANCY MASSAGE MODULE

This module is designed for therapists who would like to feel confident massaging a pregnant client. It aims to provide a solid theoretical background as well as useful and safe hands-on skills to support pregnancy. This module includes contraindications, physiological changes during pregnancy, conditions and benefits of pregnancy massage. You will master appropriate massage and positioning for each trimester using a variety of techniques. Your will learn techniques in preparation for labour, massage during labour and post-natal.

WORKING WITH CLIENTS WITH CHRONIC DISEASES

MODULE Focuses on caring, comforting and supporting clients with chronic diseases. You will learn to identity a range of chronic diseases/conditions, understand mainstream and complementary health approaches to their management and how these condition effect the body. You will learn how these diseases/ conditions have physical and psychological impacts on the client and their family. Also how treating clients with chronic diseases that may be life threatening can impact on you.

REFLEXOLOGY FOR RELAXATION MODULE

A useful tool to add to your massage menu as it is a relaxing and pleasant experience that can assist to reduce stress and promote balance. Learn and master the benefits of reflexology. Make observations of the feet and identify pathology and abnormal musculoskeletal conditions. Gain an understanding of charts and zone systems and how the bodies systems may be reflected in the feet and hands.
